Comments: The application details were assessed against the Neighbourhood Plan using the assessment matrix. The comments will be submitted to BDC Planning Department. **All agreed**.

- 13. To receive information about decisions, appeals and any other planning matters:
  - a. The proposed open space plan for Orbit Housing, Green Lane West, Rackheath was considered for adoption. It was agreed in principle to adopt this site as set out in the plan. The presence of 4 mature trees was noted and discussed specifically. These should have all required maintenance carried out before handover. It was considered that with the increased amount of open space being taken on by the Council along with the associated trees, it will be necessary to undertake a regular tree assessment for the whole village, to ensure maintenance is carried out in a timely manner. Before final sign over, the Council will require site visits with our approved contractors to ensure all work has been undertaken to the correct standard. All agreed.
